For example, a listed SBE/DBE sub is also WBE so can we split the goal to use some % for the SBE and some for the WBE?</p>

<p>Reply: ANSWER to first question: There are three Separate Goals: SBE is 15%, MBE is 10%, WBE is 5% Each of these Goals must be met separately to comply. The Total SBE/DBE + MBE + WBE is 30% Question 2: if it is 30% can one sub be used to meet multiple goals? For example, a listed SBE/DBE sub is also WBE so ANSWER to second question: Yes one sub can be used to meet multiple Goals, provided they are certified as SBE, MBE or WBE. The dollar amount cannot be doubly counted for the same scope or Items of work.</p>
