## Terry Francois Blvd. Bike/Ped Safety Improvements

#### **OVERVIEW**

The project is to redesign the northernmost block of Terry Francois Blvd (TFB) between China Basin Park and Mission Rock Street to improve safety for all roadway users and enhance streetscape aesthetics. The project includes slurry-sealing asphaltic concrete paving across the cycle track and sidewalk, installing new roadway striping, installing a physically separated 2-way cycle track on the east side of the roadway, improving the Pier 50 driveway to minimize conflicts between Port Maintenance vehicles and other large vehicles crossing the bikeway.

The total budget for this project is \$550,000.00 with a minimum LBE subcontracting goal of 20%\*
