

Ground Treatment - Concept Draft




Conceptual design focusing on eight commercially caught fish around Fisherman's Wharf: Rock cod (as bycatch), Lingcod (as bycatch), California halibut (April to November), King Salmon (May to October), Anchovies (summer months), Sardines (summer months), Albacore Tuna (August to October), and Leopard Shark (year-round, often caught recreationally and occasionally commercially).

Fisherman's Wharf CBD Grant Extension

- Port made a 2-year grant to FWCBD in July 2023 for economic recovery. In July 2024, we added funds to activate Little Embarcadero and launched the Fisherman's Wharf Promenade.
- FWCBD continues to be an effective partner to the Port in areas of beautification, events and activations, stewardship and marketing
- Having the physical presence of their ambassadors and site activation staff at the wharf every day and evening is especially helpful
- Port staff is recommending an additional 18 months of the grant in order to continue Fisherman's Wharf Promenade and other activities.
 Proposed amendment is for \$3.1M.
