Notes:

- Question: Will the existing fish signs be reused?
- Port Response: The Alioto family has the rights to the signs. If the Port has permission to use, we may plan to reinstall the existing neon signs. If not, the Port may procure new signage.
- Question: I saw Sitelab and Arcadis at the beginning of this presentation. Are those the Architect and the Developer?
- Port Response: Arcadis is the architect of record. Sitelab is the urban design consultant. Ryan Joyce Structural Design is the structural engineer of record.
- Question: What will be happening with the materials from demolition, will they be retained?
- Port Response: Some materials will be salvaged, including the existing signage. Other elements will be disposed in accordance with City of San Francisco debris recovery requirements.
- Question: We are interested in the structural lumber, which should be significant.
- Port Response: Some heavy timber components may be salvaged during demolition, but the more typical timber elements are not planned to be salvaged.
- Question: Will you be needing plumbing safe off of Alioto demo? (Closing off the plumbing lines such as water supply and sewer lines.)



- Port Response: When Alioto's Restaurant is demolished (under the separate contract), it will not require any temporary plumbing lines since the restaurants have independent systems above deck. There are some lines below deck that serve adjacent restaurants, including a force main running north to south. These elements will be preserved during demo and will need to be protected and maintained during the plaza construction work.
- Question: You may have stated this, however will this presentation be issued to those on the call?
