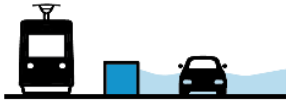

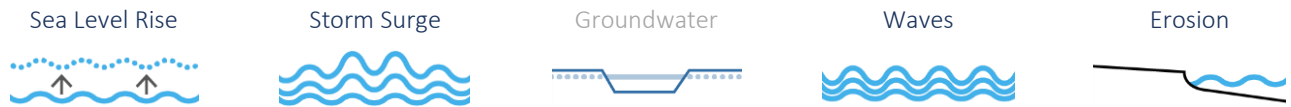
Floodwalls

DESCRIPTION:

Floodwalls are constructed on existing grade to create barriers for occasional flooding. They are typically constructed of raised concrete elements along the shoreline or upland to prevent flooding of inland assets.
