



- 30 full time staff including 6 alumni
- 20 part time Program Assistants and Sail Central Park Crew Members—all college-age alumni
- 30 paid high school-age apprentices

impact

- On average, 94% of Rocking the Boat students graduate from high school on time
- Of those, 92% enroll in college or technical schools directly out of high school
- Approximately 92% of Rocking the Boat alumni have received or are on track to receive their post-secondary certificates or bachelor's degree within six years of high school graduation
- 100% of Sailing Apprentices since 2022 have gone from having never stepped foot on a sailboat to receiving U.S. Sailing Level 1 instructor certifications.
